Does flying radio controlled model aircraft sound interesting?

Blackdown Radio Control Flying Club are looking to recruit children and teenagers as new members, and would like to invite any youngsters interested (together with a responsible adult) to come to our next major event on Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd June, between 10am and 2pm and see what our hobby is all about. This event is an Invitation Fly-in, where our own members and those from neighbouring clubs fly a wide range of model aircraft.

The Blackdown Radio Control Flying Club has been in existence for over 40 years; its flying base at Smeatharpe Airfield located in the Blackdown Hills approximately halfway between Honiton and Taunton; the entrance gateway to the airfield is immediately to the right of the entrance to Smeatharpe Stock Car and Banger Racing Stadium, EX14 4SR. We have the use of a large section of concrete runway originally used by the RAF and the US Army Airforce during World War 2. The size of the runway, both in length and width, allows for safe take-offs and landings to be made with the wind in any direction. All types of radio controlled model aircraft are flown - sport, aerobatic, scale, electric and helicopters.

The club is affiliated to the British Model Flying Association, members may not fly without supervision by an instructor or experienced flyer unless they hold at least an 'A' certificate of competence. The club has a number of qualified instructors who are happy to help the newcomers to the hobby. As an integral part of your membership we offer comprehensive flight instruction at no additional charge.
